BUNNY TREAT JAR

SUPPLIES

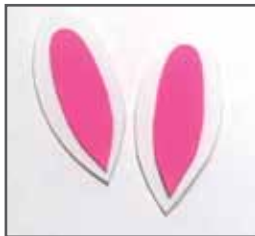
- Plastic 4 in. Jar • 30200500
- 2 qty. 2 in. x 5 in. White Foamie • 77613612 (ears)
- 2 qty. 1½ in. x 4 in. Pink Foamie • 77613596 (inner ears)
- 1 qty. 1 in. x 1½ in. Pink Foamie • 77613596 (nose)
- 2 qty. 24 mm. Moving Eyes • 30098230
- 2 qty. 1½ in. White Pom Poms • 30006982
- 2 qty. White Chenille Stems • 30110309
- 1 in. x 1 in. White Felt • 77676635 (hair tuft)
- 8 in. of ¾ in. Ribbon for bow
- Treats to fill jar

TOOLS

- Pen/Pencil for tracing
- Scissors
- Low temp Glue Gun & Glue sticks

INSTRUCTIONS

Patterns on back of sheet.

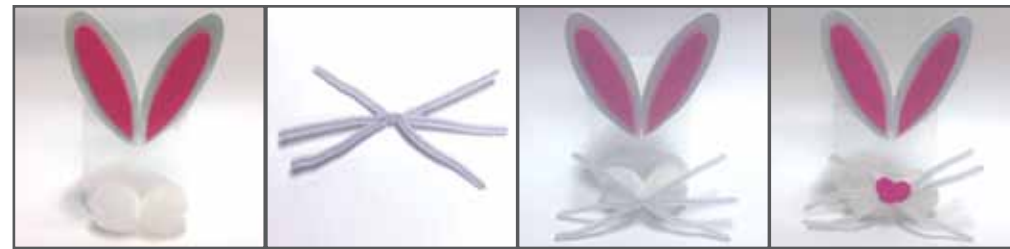


NOTE: Wash and completely dry the inside of the jar if you are planning to use unwrapped treats.

1. Trace and cut out pieces from foamies according to the pattern pieces. Take the pink inner ear pieces and center on top of the white ear pieces. Glue in place.



2. Place the ears upright on top of the front of the jar below the screw on lid. Glue in place.

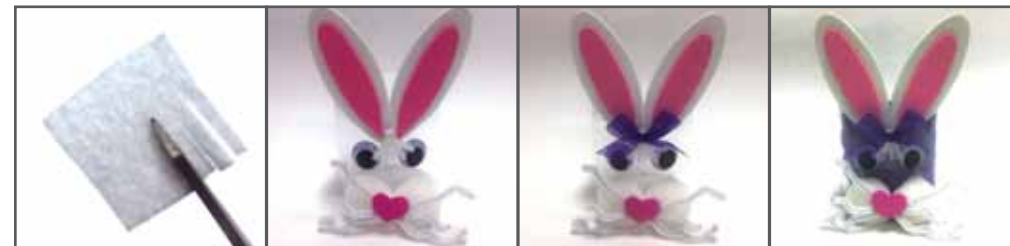


3. Glue on the two white pom poms at the bottom of the jar for the cheeks.

4. Take the 2 chenille stems and cut them in half. Take 3 of the pieces and twist together at the middle. Spread out the 6 ends to make the whiskers.

5. Glue the whiskers to the center of the pom poms.

6. Take the pink heart nose and glue on top of the whiskers center point.



7. Take the 1" white felt square and fringe cut one end, about ¾" through. On the uncut end, scrunch up and add a little glue to hold in place. Fan out the cut end to make a hair tuft.

8. Glue the hair tuft between the bottoms of the ears. Glue the 2 moving eyes above the pom pom cheeks.

9. Make a small ribbon bow and glue at the top of the hair tuft.

10. Fill the jar with treats. You can add some tissue paper first to make the treat a surprise!
