





KOKESHI DOLL LOLLIPOP COVER (PLUS BONUS GRADUATE VER.)

• 1 qty. 2 1/2 -in. x 3 1/2-in. Cardstock for tag

• 1 qty. 2-in. x 2-in. black cardstock for hair

• 1/4-in. Double stick tape #30013284

• 1-in. Circle Punch #30028719

• Paper Trimmer #30174692

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 1 qty. 2-in. x 6-in. origami paper*
- 1 qty. 1 1/2-in. x 1 1/2-in. light cardstock for face
- Black Fine Tip Sharpie marker #91029
- · Pink pencil for cheeks
- 1/4-in. Hole Punch #77178558
- 8 inches of 5/8-in. or thinner ribbon for bow
- Paper Creaser #30003774
- Pencil for tracing

For Graduate version -

- 1 qty. 2-in. x 6-in. Cardstock School color
- 2 qty. 3/16 -in x 1 1/2-in. White Cardstock (or matching school color) for Grad Robe Collar
- 1 qty. 3-in x 3-in. Cardstock for Grad Cap
- 12-inches of Embroidery floss for tassel
- 1/16-in. Hole punch #77178533 or similar for brad
- Mini Brad coordinating color for grad cap button
- Foam Dot
- 1-in. x 1-in. copy paper for diploma
- 6-inches of floss to tie diploma

NOTE: Using thicker paper like cardstock will be a little harder to fold but is still achievable.

If you are not making a lollipop cover and just the Kokeshi doll, you can use any size of paper, but the dimensions need to be such that the longer length is 3 times the width. Example 4 in. wide x 12 in. long, 3 in. wide x 9 in. long.



INSTRUCTIONS



1. a) Fold the 2-in. x 6-in. paper into thirds in a zig zag design. Crease well.

b) With the end section that has the paper design right side up, fold the edge over 1/4-inch to the back.

NOTE: If using a different size of paper, this is equal to about 1/8 of the section.



2. Find the center point of the square. On this top section only, fold each corner to the center. Crease well. This will be the collar.



3. a) Take the sides, with all three-layers of thickness, and fold to the center stopping at the edge of the collar. Crease well.

b) Fold back just the top layer of the sides. A small triangle will form at the top. Crease well.



4. Fold the top down to the back, leaving just the top point of the collar extended. Crease well.



5. Fold the bottom edge about two thirds up to the back to reveal the sleeves. Crease well.

Your Happi Coat/ Kimono is done.

You can use your happi coat as is for a pin or decoration.



6. To create a kokeshi doll -

Punch a 1-inch circle from light colored cardstock for the face.

Trace and cut out hair from black cardstock according to the pattern.

Place face behind the hair and tape in place. Draw in the eyes and cheeks.



7. Place Kokeshi Doll Head on the top of the happi coat collar and tape in place



8. Tag - Make a diagonal cut at the corners of one edge of the 2 1/2-in x 1/2-in. cardstock to create the tag.


Punch a hole in the center of that edge of the tag.

9. Place the lollipop behind the tag and insert the stick through the hole. Tape the lollipop to the tag.



10. Tape the Kokeshi Doll to the front of the tag. Add a bow to the stick at the bottom of the tag to finish.



11. **To Create a Graduate Version –** Make the Kimono in a solid color. Add two 3/16-in. strips down the center to make a Graduation gown.



12. Follow step 6 to make the graduate head.

Trim the hair for a boy version.

Tape head to the graduation gown.



13. **Tassel -** Cut the embroidery floss into 3 strands and knot together at one end. Braid the strands together. Knot after 2-inches of braid and trim off floss, leaving about 1/4-inch tail. Spread the end strands of the tail to make the tassel.



14. Trace and cut out pieces from cardstock for the grad cap according to the patterns.

Punch a hole in the center of the top of the cap. Thread the tassel through and hold in place with the brad.



15. Position the cap bottom on the top of the head and tape down. Place the cap top on and attach with a foam dot.

For a diploma - roll a 1-in. wide piece of copy paper and tie with a ribbon or thread. Attach to the end of a sleeve.

Add the graduate to a tag.



16. Use the Graduate Lollipop Cover as a party favor or place inside a clear cello bag and attach to a lei.
