PAPER BUNNY

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 7- 9 sheets of newspaper (Midweek size)
- Twine #77437103 or string for tying
- White Acrylic Paint #77624882
- 2 aty. 20mm Moving Eyes #30055152
- 2 qty. White Chenille Stem #77858910
- 1.5" x 1.5" Felt Shocking Pink #30147521 for nose
- 18" of ribbon for bow around neck
- Adhesive Tacky Glue #30172711 or Craft Glue Dots #30001508
- 1" Foam brush #10109
- Scissors
- Optional:
- Low temp Glue Gun #77536417 & Glue sticks #30148555
- Sharpie Black Marker #91029



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Take 3 - 4 sheets of newspaper (Midweek size) and crunch into a ball.



6. Fringe cut the shorter ends of the wrap at the base of the ears as "bangs."



2. Take 2 sheets of newspaper and lay them in front of you. Place the paper ball on top, two thirds away from the right edge.



7. Paint the bunny head, including the ears with the white acrylic paint. Let dry. Or, you can leave the bunny unpainted.



3. Bring the sides up around the paper ball to cover the ball. The left side of the wrap should extend above the ball. Hold the gathered paper together above the ball.



8. Glue on the eyes. Cut the chenille stems in half, take 3 pieces and twist together in the middle to make the whiskers. Glue whiskers below the eyes. Cut a heart shape nose from felt and glue on top of the center of the whiskers. Tie a ribbon over the string and into a bow.



4. Take another two sheets of newspaper and place the bottom of the wrapped ball on top, this time two thirds form the left edge. Gather the same way and tie a piece of string to secure.



5. Separate the two sections at the top. Twist each one and shape into bunny ears.
