



CAKE SLICE BOX CAR

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

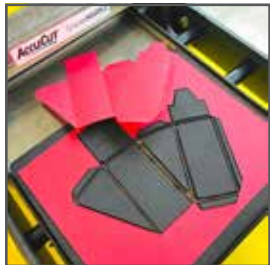
- Small Cake Slice Box Die Cut from Cardstock- Accu Cut #BX280CJ *
- 4 in. x 4 in. Black Cardstock for Tires
- 3 in. x 3 in. Cardstock, your color choice for Tire Rims
- 2 in. x 3 in. Clear Acetate #30086639 for the Windshield
- Assorted Cardstock and/or stickers for decorating car (racing stripes, flames, numbers, etc.)
- 1-½ in. Circle punch #30028731
- 1 in. Circle Punch #30028719 or Small Star Punch #30028711, etc. for the Tire Rim
- ¼ in. Double Stick Tape #30013284
- Glue Dots - Craft ½ in. #3000150
- Scissors
- Markers, Stamps, etc. for decorating



NOTE: When you purchase your cardstock from HouseMart Ben Franklin Crafts, you can use the Accu Cut Die cutting system for free (see store for details)

The Small Cake Slice Box is one of the dies available.

INSTRUCTIONS



1. Cut cake slice box from 8.5 in. x 11 in. cardstock using the Accu Cut Die Cutting system in the store.

Crease all the scored lines.



2. Put ¼ in. double stick tape on the long side tab and the adjacent short tab at the end.



3. Fold the box into the cake slice box shape, taping the tabs down to hold together.



4. Close the box by folding in the tabs and slipping the tab into the slot. Turn the cake slice on its side.



5. Trace and cut out the windshield from clear acetate. Fold the bottom straight edge and tape to the car as shown.

Using stickers, cardstocks, stamps or markers, decorate the car as you want. Add racing stripes down the center, flames on the side. You can add a driver, racing car number or a name.

6. Tires - From black cardstock, punch out four circles from the 1-½ in. circle punch.

Create the rims by cutting from cardstock 1 in. circles or small stars using punches and gluing to the center of the tires. You can also draw on the circle with markers or use stickers.

INSTRUCTIONS (continued)



7. Use Glue Dots to add the tires onto the car as shown. Match up the placement of each tire on each side so the car is level.



8. Open the box up to put treats inside to use as a favor or gift.

WINDSHIELD PATTERN

Windshield
Cut 1 from Clear Acetate
Crease at dotted line.
