



PULL UP TREAT HOLDER

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 10 1/2 in. x 6 1/2 in. White Cardstock for the treat holder base
- 5 qty. 1/2 in. x 6 1/2 in. Red Cardstock for stripes
- 2 1/2 in. x 3 in. Cardstock for the message embellishment – top layer with sentiment
- 2 3/4 in. in. x 3 1/4 in. Cardstock for the message embellishment – bottom layer
- Scrap White Cardstock for popcorn
- Yellow and Orange markers for popcorn
- Double Stick Tape
- 1/4-inch Hole Punch
- 28 inches of 5/8 in. ribbon
- Score Board
- Paper Trimmer
- Scissors
- Packet of Microwave popcorn*

Optional:

- Stamp & ink pad for sentiment, markers, stickers, etc.

NOTE: These measurements are for a packet of microwave popcorn approximately 4 in. x 6 in. x 3/8 in. You can adjust the size of your treat holder for a gift card, candy bar or other treat. Just wrap cardstock around the treat to get your measurement. Ribbon length will need to be adjusted as well.

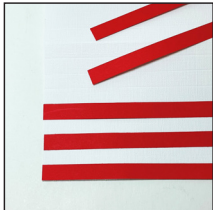


INSTRUCTIONS



1. Place the white cardstock onto the score board with the 10 1/2 in. edge along the top. Score at: 1/2 in., 1 in., 5 1/2 in. 6 in. for the holder base.

Crease at the scored lines to get the base of the treat holder.
To make the “popcorn box” stripes, continue scoring every half inch at: 6 1/2 in., 7 in., 7 1/2 in. 8 in., 8 1/2 in., 9 in., 9 1/2 in. and 10 in.



2. Starting from the 10 in. mark, place the red stripes down, every other row. Tape in place



3. Assembling the holder - Fold up the treat holder with the first 1/2 inch scored section overlapping under the opposite straight edge. Use double stick tape onto 1/2 in. section and adhere to form the treat holder.



4. Take the 1/4 in. hole punch and punch a hole on the center stripe about 1/2 in. from the edge. Punch the hole through both thicknesses.

Thread the ribbon through the holes with the ends of the ribbon evenly matched.



5. Insert the popcorn packet into the holder by placing onto the center of the ribbon and pushing down.



6. Bring the ends of the ribbon together and tie into a bow at the top.

The ribbon will hold the popcorn packet in place.



7. To get the popcorn packet, pull the bow up and the popcorn packet will slide up



8. Decorate the front of the holder as desired.

You can add a fun message and glue on popcorn embellishments, etc.
