- Keyring, 1 pc (30221628)
- Bead Mat 11"x14" (30031548)

- Aleene's Stop Fraying Glue (30103409)



• BIC Lighter (6092183)

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Lay out the Pony Bead Pizza pattern on a bead mat in a triangular shape.
- 2. Cut Grosgrain Ribbon ends at a deep angle and dab Aleene's Stop Fraying Glue to the ends. Or for a quicker approach, melt ends quickly with the BIC Lighter.
- 3. String the first top bead onto Grosgrain Ribbon in the middle, fold the ribbon in half to find the middle.
- 4. Next row of beads, take the two beads and string them onto one side of the ribbon. Feed the other end of the ribbon through the beads doing a beader's basic ladder stitch. Pull both ends to tighten. (Even though the ribbon is tricky to thread, we found that when finished it feels more sturdy and less saggy compared to using rattail.)









- 5. Repeat ladder stitch for each row of beads.
- 6. After the last row is finished bring both ends together and tie in the middle. Cut off excess ribbon at a 45-degree angle. To keep a clean look, repeat step 2.
- 7. Add the keyring to the top bead to finish it off.
