- Clips for holding the folded pages
- Tacky Glue \#1360916
- Low Temp Gun \& Glue sticks
- Clip or clothespin is helpful for holding pages
- Craft Knife \#77504092


## Additional:

- Decorations for tree
- Paint or other coloring mediums



## INSTRUCTIONS


5. Unfold the point and lift up the page's larger fold.
can leave the covers on.
2. Begin folding, starting from the first page. Take the top right corner of the page and fold to the center of the book. Crease well.
3. Fold the angled edge of the page to the center, lining up with the spine. Crease well. If you are going to place your tree on a stand or pedestal, you can go to step 7.
4. If you want a straight edge for the bottom of your tree, continue by folding the page point sticking out over the bottom edge of the book. Crease well.

9. If you keep the points on the bottom of your tree, you will need to elevate the tree and attach it to a base such as a candlestick, wood block, etc.

You can leave your tree as is or decorate it. Glue on small ornaments and trims. Add a tree topper if you wish
10. You can also make a half tree in the center of the book and use the pages on either side of the book as a backdrop.
You'll need to calculate about 100-120 pages for the tree in the center of the book to find the page to start your folding.

Decorate the backdrop with paint and other embellishments.
6. Tuck the point into the larger fold for a clean finish.
7. Continue folding the pages of the book. As you fold the pages, you may need to use clips to hold the already folded pages together, making it easier to fold the new pages.
8. The folded pages/book spine will start to curl, making the folded pages form a circular shape for the tree.
