Girl's Day Pin

Supplies:

1 1/4" x 1 1/4" Flesh Foamie #7761 3463 1 1/4" x 1 1/4" Black Foamie #7761 3620 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" Pink Foamie #7761 3604 1" x 1" Light Green Foamie #7761 3570 Yellow Acrylic Paint #7762 4874 Black Acrylic Paint #7762 4890 Thin Paintbrush Black fine Tip Permanent Marker #91029 1" Pin back – gold #7740 3337 or Silver #7712 6987 Low Temp Glue gun & glue sticks




Directions:

Trace and cut out pieces from foamies according to the patterns.

Take the fine tip marker and lightly draw the lines on the center of the flower as pictured in the sample. Use the rounded end of the thin paintbrush and dip dot the yellow paint on the center of the flower. Let dry.

Position the hair on top of the head and glue in place. Use the rounded end of the thin paintbrush and dip dot two eyes with the black paint. Let dry.

Place the girl's head peeking out from pening the flower on the upper left side. Glue in place. Place the two leaves behing the flower on the bottom right and glue in place. Glue pip back behind the girl's head

1 1/4" x 1 1/4" Flesh Foamie #7761 3463 1 1/4" x 1 1/4" Black Foamie #7761 3620 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" Pink Foamie #7761 3604 1" x 1" Light Green Foamie #7761 3570 Yellow Acrylic Paint #7762 4874 Black Acrylic Paint #7762 4890 Thin Paintbrush Black fine Tip Permanent Marker #91029 1" Pin back – gold #7740 3337 or Silver #7712 6987 Low Temp Glue gun & glue sticks




Directions:

Trace and cut out pieces from foamies according to the patterns.
