

4. Turn the paper over so the right side of the paper is Re-fold so the right side of facing up. Position the paper the paper is showing. like a square in front of you.

5. Fold in half. Crease well.









7. After pushing both sides down and in, you should have a layered triangle.

8. Lift the point from the top 9. Repeat steps 1-8 with the layer on the right and fold down so it aligns with the center of the triangle. Crease well.
