



EZ ORIGAMI TREE CARD

MATERIALS & TOOLS

- 3 pcs. of Paper or Cardstock for the tree, 1 each: 3 in. x 3 in., 2.5 in. x 2.5 in., 2 in x 2 in.
- Card Base*
- 1/4 in. Double Stick Tape #30013284 or Liquid Glue for paper
- Optional: Embellishment - sequins, buttons, stickers, glitter glue, etc.
- Paper Creaser #30003774

NOTE: The samples shown used 4.5 in x 4.5 in and 3.75 in x 3.75 in card bases



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Take the 3 in. x 3 in. square and position it on point like a diamond, with the right side of the paper facing down.



2. Fold in half with the top point down to the bottom point, making a triangle. Crease well and unfold.

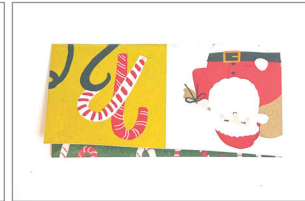


3. Next, fold in half side to side. Crease well. Unfold.

INSTRUCTIONS (Continued)



4. Turn the paper over so the right side of the paper is facing up. Position the paper like a square in front of you.



5. Fold in half. Crease well. Re-fold so the right side of the paper is showing.



6. Start a squash fold by pushing the top creased line downwards and into the triangle folds.



7. After pushing both sides down and in, you should have a layered triangle.



8. Lift the point from the top down so it aligns with the center of the triangle. Crease well.



9. Repeat steps 1-8 with the two smaller squares.

Repeat this step with the left side point.



10. Stack the triangles, smallest down to the largest to form the tree. Slip the triangle points slightly into the piece above.



11. Finish the card by adding embellishments like sequins, stickers, glitter glue, etc.

Experiment with different types of papers and designs. Using different color schemes gives the cards very different looks.

Tape pieces together. Place onto the card front and tape down.
