

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Ice Cream® Deluxe Sorbet Knit Baby Afghan

Pattern Number: L90235



SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZES

About 30 x 30 in. (76 x 76 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Ice Cream® Deluxe (Art. #912)
 - #220 Ortley 3 cakes
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 10 (6 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

GAUGE

13 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every st on every row). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

Yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

- 1. Bring varn to front, between the needles.
- 2. Take yarn to back, over the right hand needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

NOTES

- 1. Afghan is worked in one piece on a circular needle.
- 2. The circular needle is used to accommodate the number of stitches. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle, just as if working on straight needles.
- 3. The Afghan is worked diagonally, from corner to corner, and shaped with increases and decreases.

AFGHAN

Cast on 5 sts.

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: K2, yo, k2 – you will have 6 sts.

Row 3: K2, yo, k2 - 7 sts.

Row 4: K2, yo, k to end of row.

Repeat Row 4 until you have 120 sts on your needle.

Next (Decrease) Row: K1, k2tog, yo, k2tog, k to end of row.

Repeat last row until 6 sts remain.

Last Row: K2, k2tog, yo, k2tog. Bind off remaining 5 sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit
k2tog = knit 2 stitches together
st(s) = stitch(es)
