### **IMAGE TRANSFER WOOD DECOR**

#### **SUPPLIES & TOOLS**

- Wood Disk w/ Tassel (30228506)
- Matte Gel Medium (77521575)
- Foam Brush
- Pencil
- Sparkle Eyelash Yarn or Scrubby Yarn
- Crochet Hook
- Hot Glue Gun-Low Temp
- Glue Gun Sticks
- Sponge
- Water



#### INSTRUCTIONS

- Print out an image of your choice using an inkjet printer on plain printer paper, make sure it fits the wood disk. (If printing words, reverse/mirror the image before printing). Cut out the image as close as possible.
- Place the cutout centered onto the wood disk, the image facing down, and lightly trace the outline with the Pencil. Remove the cutout. Using the Foam Brush, brush approx. 1mm thick coat of the Matte Gel Medium within the traced lines on the Wood Disk. Immediately place your image face-down on top of the gel medium and gently press out any air bubbles. Allow the gel medium to dry for about 4 hours.
- Crochet the yarn into a chain stitch, till the diameter length of the wood disk.
- Once dry, begin peeling off the paper using the sponge. Wet the sponge with water and gently rub off the paper in a circular motion, be careful not to remove the image transfer. Keep the sponge wet till all the paper is removed.
- Glue the crocheted chain stitch with the hot glue gun around the transferred image creating a frame.
- Hang and enjoy!
